Rent Deposit Guarantee Scheme assists people on low incomes who are in housing need access private sector tenancies across Dumfries and Galloway.

Weekly Private Sector Tenancies Information Service provides up to date information on available private sector tenancies in Dumfries and Galloway to assist people in housing need.

Winter Warmth for Older People provides a free logs and kindling service for older people in Dumfries and Galloway who use open fires and who experience fuel poverty.

Getting Connected Project assists people apply online for benefits, create CV's, carry out job searches and apply for jobs, as well as providing learning sessions on using computers.

Community Defibrillators Project provides defibrillator units and training for local communities in rural areas at some distance from emergency services.

SPRING Social Prescribing Project assists people through facilitating access to local support networks to improve their health and wellbeing.
