Projects the hub develops and delivers

Rent Deposit Guarantee Scheme assists people on low incomes who are in housing need access private sector tenancies by providing deposit bonds to landlords.

Weekly Private Sector Tenancies Information Service provides up to date information on available private sector tenancies in Dumfries and Galloway to assist people in housing need and agencies providing housing advice.

Getting Connected Project assists people apply online for benefits, create CV's, carry out job searches and apply for jobs, as well as providing 1 to 1 learning sessions on using computers and internet enabled devices.

Help with Heating Scheme assists households on means tested benefits who use electricity, gas, oil, LPG and coal to heat their homes.

SPRING Social Prescribing Project assists people to improve their health and wellbeing by supporting and connecting them with activities in their local community.

Community Defibrillators Project provides low cost defibrillators and training for local communities in rural areas of Dumfries and Galloway.
